

What do you need to set up an account?

You need access to an email account to set up a Doddle Parent account.



When you log in to Doodle Parent, you will see progress data where it exists in that academic year for every subject switched on.

You will see the most recent red, amber, green and 'recently assessed' skill in each subject.

What will you see?

There is a panel entitled “What does this information mean?” This panel explains what the icons mean and how the skills are ordered.

Your child's school assesses their attainment by judging their ability in individual skills.

The most recently rated red, amber, or green skills appear first.

You can support your child by focusing on their red and amber skills.

The red, amber and green skills are ordered by how recently they were rated. Skills that have just been rated appear as "recently assessed".
