This document sets out the provision for students' learning in case one or more of the scenarios occurs.

	Students all in college	Some students self-isolating	Class at home
Teacher in college	Lessons will be taught as normal but with Covid restrictions in place as laid out in the risk assessment.	<p>Parents should notify the college that their child is at home but well enough to attend lessons remotely.</p> <p>Dedicated teaching teams set assignments on Canvas for students to complete at home Labelled: [Year] [Subject] home study [teacher] [date range] / [topic]</p>	<p>Registration meeting via a Teams meeting, linked from Canvas 9am every day. Teacher at home (well)	<p>Students go to classroom as normal.</p> <p>Cover teacher assigned to the lesson. Teacher sends Teams link to cover teacher, for the teacher at home to deliver lesson.</p>	<p>Teacher to teach lessons as per the timetable from home but provide students at home access to the lesson via a Teams meeting, linked in an announcement in the course areas in Canvas. Labelled: [Year] [Subject] lesson [date] / topic</p> <p>Students at home log onto Canvas and follow link in announcements to Teams lesson. Complete pre-planned assignments in Canvas Labelled: [Year] [Subject] home study [teacher] [date range] / [topic]</p>	<p>Registration meeting via a Teams meeting, linked from Canvas 9am every day. Labelled: Registration [group name]</p> <p>Students log into Canvas and link to Teams remotely on their own devices for their timetabled lesson with cameras off and microphones muted.</p> <p>Teacher to teach lessons as per the timetable from home by providing students at home access to the lesson via a Teams meeting, linked in an <u>announcement</u> in the course areas in Canvas. Labelled: [Year] [Subject] lesson [date] / topic</p>
Teacher unable to deliver the lesson	Work will be set for the cover teacher to deliver	<p>Students self-isolating will have assignments uploaded on to Canvas. Labelled: [Year] [Subject] home study [teacher] [date range] / [topic]</p>	<p>Assignments uploaded on to Canvas according to the timetable. Labelled: [Year] [Subject] home study [teacher] [date range] / [topic]</p>
